The 2015 Carneros Estate Pinot Noir is pale to medium ruby-purple in color with gregarious notes of Bing cherries, rhubarb and pomegranate with suggestions of black pepper, truffles, forest floor and sautéed herbs. The palate is medium-bodied with a fine frame of grainy tannins and background freshness lifting the red berry and earth flavors to a long finish. 700 cases were made.

Medium to full-bodied and savory in the mouth with firm, chunky tannins and just enough freshness, it finishes with a spark of cracked black pepper. 325 cases produced.

The palate is medium-bodied, finely crafted, refreshing and elegant, offering fine-grained tannins with a bit of stemmy chew and finishing with lingering earth layers. 150 cases were made.

Oak is still poking through on the light to medium-bodied palate, with a wicked backbone of acidity defining the fruit, finishing long and minerally. Give it a couple more years in bottle and drink it over the next 10 to 12+ years. 120 cases were made.
