2019 SINGLE-VINEYARD RESERVE ANDERSON VALLEY PINOT NOIR ANGEL CAMP

INTRODUCTION

The Angel Camp Estate Vineyard Pinot Noir represents our top barrel blend from this impressive hillside vineyard in Anderson Valley. With seven different clones planted, the vineyard provides plenty of variety to work with, presenting a unique blending challenge. Each year the various blocks react to the growing season a little bit differently, and the blend varies accordingly. When we decided to work with Anderson Valley fruit, our goal was to create a wine that stays true to the terroir of the region but also expresses the Donum style of Pinot Noir. This elegant, expressive, and balanced Pinot Noir is exactly what we had in mind.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Ruby in color with aromas of violets, raspberry, cherry and rose petal, the 2019 Angel Camp has a broad, expansive mouthfeel. Flavors of boysenberry, cherry, flint, tobacco, and blood orange each take a turn on the palate, with an intense, well-structured finish. The wine gains complexity after being open for several days, which suggests a very long life ahead in the cellar. Recommended drinking window is 2022-2030.
