



The Donum Difference

Donum is a leader in single-vineyard, single-appellation Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from Northern California.

Our terroir-driven wines capture the energy and complexity of some of the most celebrated regions in Northern California, including Russian River Valley, Carneros, Anderson Valley and the Sonoma Coast. To achieve this, Donum farms for low yields using organic, regenerative farming practices, cultivating a thriving environment in which the vines can flourish.

The Donum Collection features more than 60 monumental works, including open-air sculptures, thoughtfully placed throughout the Estate. Each work explores themes of scale, nature and imagination, forming and ever-evolving dialogue between art and landscape. This evolving collection brings together a global community of artists, with works by leading practitioners from 18 nations across six continents.



Meet Our Esteemed Winemaker Dan Fishman

An integral part of the winemaking team since 2007, Dan Fishman began his journey at the Donum Estate as an intern under former winemaker Kenneth Juhasz. After five vintages working with Juhasz, Dan was promoted to oversee Donum's winemaking responsibilities. By then, he had developed a deep understanding of the Estate's three vineyards, allowing for a seamless transition that maintained Donum's tradition of excellence, crafting some of the most sought-after and highly rated Pinot Noirs and Chardonnays from Northern California.

In 2019, Dan assumed leadership of Donum's estate vineyards and spearheaded the Estate's transition to organic farming. The initiative led to CCOF Organic Certification in the summer of 2022, followed by Regenerative Organic Certified[™] status for all five of Donum's Estate vineyards in the spring of 2023.

Deeply attuned to the nuances of each vineyard block, Dan's winemaking approach combines historically known and cutting-edge techniques, allowing each lot to express its unique character. "For me, great wine is all about capturing the energy of the place where the vineyard is planted. I believe this starts with the soil and the vine root system, which is why we farm organically with no herbicides to encourage a healthy soil biome. In the winery, my philosophy is to try to intervene as little as possible, to allow the vineyard to speak for itself through the wine." – Dan Fishman, "Art of the Vine," San Francisco Magazine




Expansive Site-Specific Art Collection, The Donum Collection[°]





Donum Practices Work With Nature And Yield Higher Quality Fruit

While our regenerative farming practices begin with the soil, the positive impact is seen through the entire winemaking process:



Soil

Everything starts with creating healthy soil – high organic matter, improved water holding capacity, better soil structure, and greater presence of beneficial soil fungi.



Vines

The result is optimal mineral and nutrient cycling, enabling our vines to activate their natural immune systems to combat disease and pest pressures.



Grapes

Our vines can then regulate their vigor and growthachieving balance-only setting the crop they can ripen optimally.



Wine

With balanced vines, root growth, vegetative growth, and fruit ripening work in harmony, resulting in fruit with ideal chemistry that requires less adjustments in the winery.

Carneros Chardonnay

Carneros is renowned for exceptional Chardonnay, and we couldn't resist planting a small block of our own. Our Old Wente clone originates from budwood sourced from Winery Lake and Larry Hyde vineyards, a charming field selection that offers a spectrum of aromas and flavors, from classic apple to banana to notes of floral, occasionally revealing the heady perfume of a musqué cluster. Our goal is to craft a Chardonnay that delivers maximum complexity while remaining vibrant.
