Due to the growing demand and recognition of The Donum Collection, Donum is delighted to be able to welcome more audiences to experience one of the largest accessible private sculpture collections in the world with "The Donum Collection Art Tour". A communal, 90-minute walking tour of the Estate, comprising some 50 works of site specific-sculpture and works of art. Included on the tour, the Donum Home that houses works from El Anatsui (Born Ghana, 1944) and Liu Xiaodong (Born China, 1963); the sculpture garden featuring Zodiac heads by Ai Weiwei (Born China, 1957); and a white cube conservation space that houses Crouching Spider by Louise Bourgeois (Born France, 1911 – 2010). To coincide with the launch, an interactive map has been made accessible for everyone to experience the collection online. The Donum Collection Art Tour - 1.5 Hours | \$95/person

The tour is designed for guests interested in The Donum Collection, one of the largest accessible private sculpture collections in the world. Guests enjoy a communal, 90-minute walking tour of the Estate featuring works including "Zodiac Heads" by Ai Weiwei, "Love Me" by Richard Hudson, "People Tree" by Subodh Gupta, "Sonic Mountain" by Doug Aitken, and "Crouching Spider" by Louise Bourgeois. This experience is solely a tour of the art and excludes a wine tasting. Available Wednesday - Sunday.

Transcend Experience - 3 Hours | \$500/person minimum

Hosted in the Vertical Panorama Pavilion, inspired by the natural elements of the surrounding vineyards, this intimate tasting provides guests with a holistic sensory experience. An ultimate exploration of wine, land, and art, guests receive a guided tour of the Estate, including the extensive Donum Collection of global art, before meeting the chef in the culinary garden to sample seasonal produce. This experience includes a wine tasting of estate, single-block reserve, and library wines, paired with a seasonally-driven, internationally-inspired tasting menu featuring estate-grown produce. Available Friday – Sunday.

Explore Experience - 2 Hours | \$175/person

Designed for the guest who is looking for a more exclusive, in-depth exploration of everything Donum Estate has to offer. Starting with a taste of one of Donum's award-winning wines and an all-terrain vehicle tour of the Estate, visitors will then embark upon a private tasting featuring seasonal wines and canapés in a serene, elegant open-air tasting salon. Available Friday – Sunday.

Discover Experience - 1.5 Hours | \$125/person

This experience is ideal for both new and returning visitors interested in discovering and learning about all aspects of the Estate and winery. It starts with a splash of one of Donum's award-winning wines and a walking tour of the Estate, followed by a private tasting of seasonal wines thoughtfully paired with canapés. Available Monday - Sunday at 10 a.m., 1 p.m., and 3 p.m.
