Inaugural Savoy Vineyard Wines from The Donum Estate Hit the Market

(Anderson Valley, CA – September 29, 2025) – The Donum Estate, a leading producer of world-class Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, proudly announces the inaugural release of wines from its Savoy Vineyard—a historic site in Anderson Valley.

The debut wines from Savoy Vineyard will be released beginning in Fall 2025, featuring Savoy Chardonnay (\$85), and three Pinot Noir reserve wines: Perrygulch Pinot Noir (\$125), noted for its broad appeal, balance, and purity of fruit character; Pinole Pinot Noir (\$125), offering a dark fruit expression with lower acidity; and Hendy Knoll Pinot Noir (\$125), a structured, lighter style wine made with whole-cluster fermentation, reminiscent of The Donum Estate’s White Barn and Ten Oaks Pinot Noir wines.

“These wines showcase hallmark characteristics of Anderson Valley: mineral notes, harmonious balance of earthy and fruity flavors, and a subtle mint or redwood nuance from the surrounding forests and native plants,” said Dan Fishman, Winemaker at The Donum Estate.

The 2023 growing season was marked by a wet winter, which resulted in later budbreak and a relatively cool growing season, leading to slow, even ripening. “These cooler, later growing seasons are ideal for making the kind of concentrated yet balanced wines we strive for,” said Fishman. “The 2023 vintage allowed the fruit to ripen slowly and evenly, without losing natural acidity to heat. The result is wines with depth of flavor and elegance, at a slightly lower alcohol level than we typically see in California.”

The Donum Estate acquired the 52-acre Savoy Vineyard in the heart of Anderson Valley in 2023, reinforcing Donum's commitment to farming and producing wines that display a sense of place across a broad geographical footprint. In December 2024, Savoy achieved Regenerative Organic Certified® (ROC®) status, making it Donum’s fifth estate vineyard to earn this designation, an affirmation of Donum’s strong belief in the value of regenerative farming, land stewardship, and uncompromising quality.

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Alongside the debut of wines from Savoy Vineyard, Donum is releasing select 2023 wines from its vineyards in Carneros, further highlighting the vintage's remarkable character across its diverse vineyard sites.
